He has delivered keynote presentations at major conferences in the Albany region including the New York State School Nurses Association annual spring and fall conferences. MYA PHAN

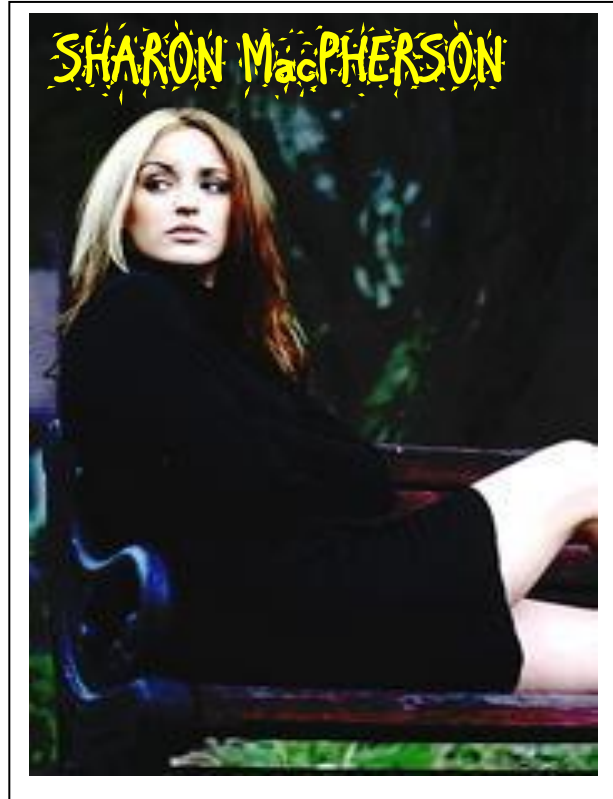

Female Recording Artists Performing and Speaking at Girl Conference 2011



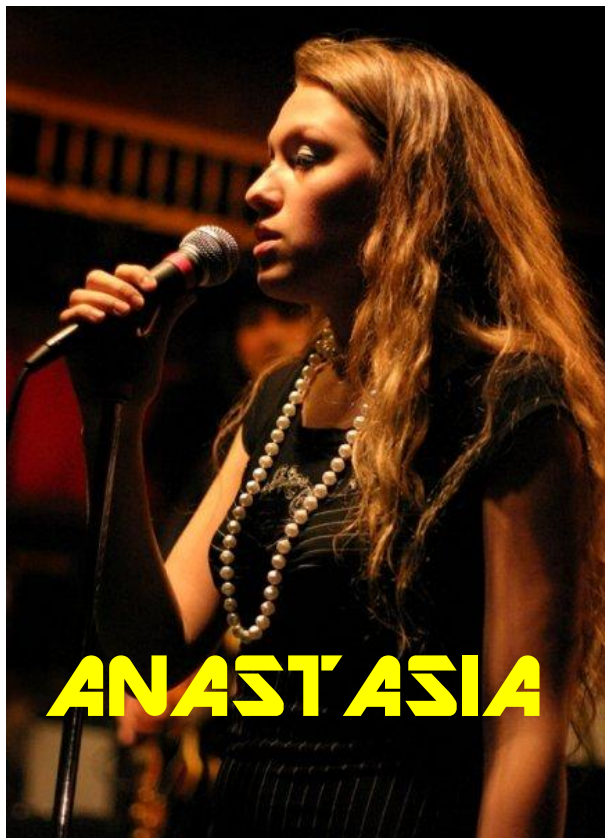
